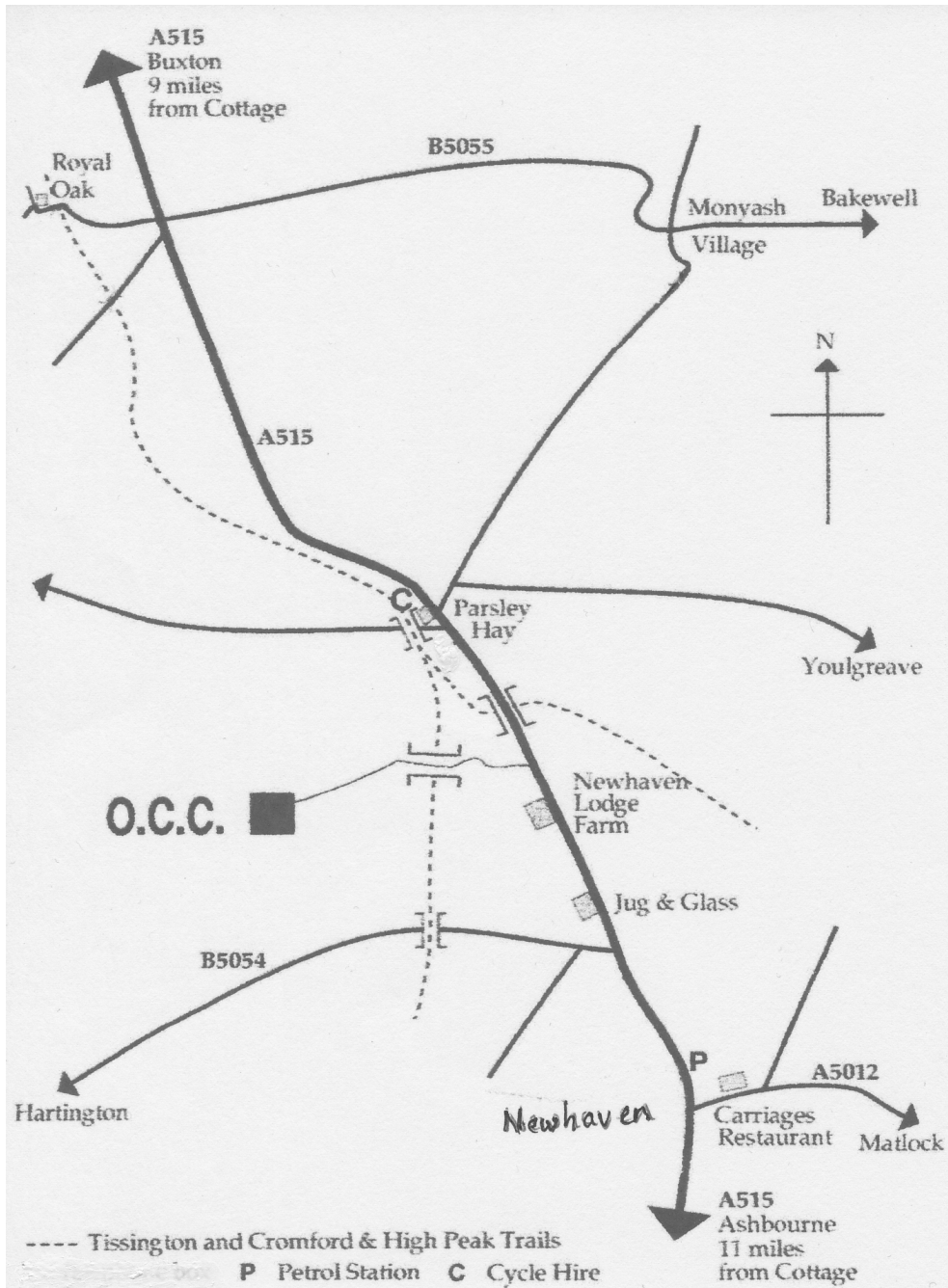


ORPHEUS COTTAGE LOCATION

Note that the Cottage cannot be seen from the road; its post code is shared by 3 other isolated farms, so SatNav systems are no help.

The Cottage is reached by ½ mile unfenced track across farmland, leading up and over a hill, across a railway bridge over the Tissington Trail and down to the Cottage. The first part of the track is unmade but it is tarmacked from just above the bridge down to the Cottage.

The entrance to the track, on the west side of the main A515, lies between Newhaven Lodge Farm and the Parsley Hay crossroads. The 1st. cattle grid is set well back from the road between curving drystone walls.

Heading north from Ashbourne, the track entrance is on the left, 1 mile past the Jug and Glass Pub and ¼ mile past Newhaven Lodge Farm.

Heading south from Buxton, it is on the right, ½ mile past the Parsley Hay crossroads (at the bottom of the dip) and just after the road levels out at the top of the hill.

Markers at the roadside are:

Roadside end of the track - Road cone with no reflecting jacket. (Beware, other farms on this stretch of road also use road cones to mark entrances!)

North side of track entrance: (Set back from the road next to the metal rubbish bunker) tall metal pole with reflecting red triangles set in a diamond shape on top.

Opposite side of the road: Post with rectangular amber reflecting markers and red reflecting stripes, with sign pointing to track saying "Peak View Campsite".
