awarded the Piolet d'Or in 2022. He has postponed a trip to Patagonia to be with us. Silvo's presentation starts at 5pm in the hotel.

- Or simply socialise with friends at Lowstern.



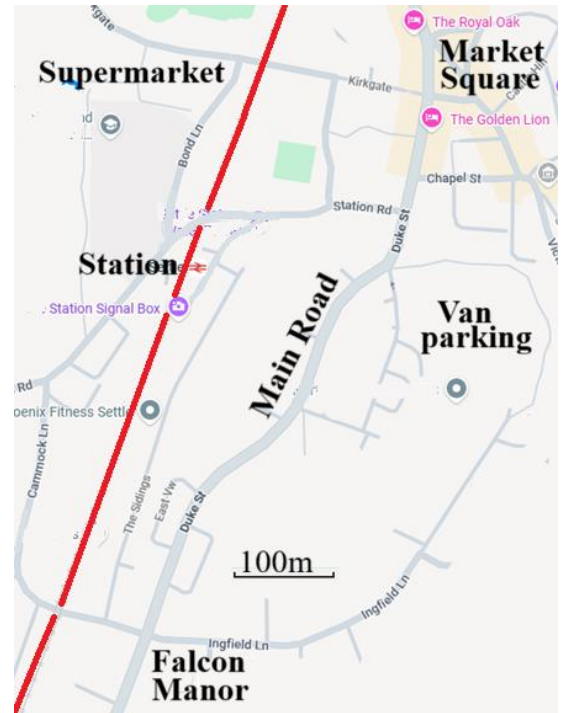
Hotel rooms available from 3pm, Lowstern available all weekend
